

Joyful BECOMING



After 3 wonderful years investing in the life of PBC he and Sam will be pastoring Penrith City Chapel and investing in church planting with GWFC.
- The Church and Ministry Leadership teams are delighted to recommend after 3 months of discernment we affirm Pastor Emmah Makuthi for a 1 day paid role in the Ministry Leadership Team for "Mission and Community" along with preaching and teaching in Penrith Baptist Church.

- Contined to create community through Craft Circle and Men's Shed


- Establish a leader of our Missions & Community ministry

2024/25 Report & Budget



Budget Notes

- The 2025 Budget is a break even budget but does include a faith step for increase in general giving and mission giving.
- There is now inclusion of rental income from Clementines Cafe in 2025
- The Mission Giving target will include Destiny Rescue, Samaritans Purse, Baptist World Aid, SRE, Chaplaincy, Gen1K Baptist Association, local opportunities & another overseas mission.
- There is growing opportunities for facility hire that is grounded in our vision to serve our community and city.
- Although not included in the 2025 budget figures we are delighted to support the Glenmore Park High chaplaincy which has been fully funded by the school for 2025
